Procedure for Admission to BDS course for A.Y.2016-2017

For Academic Year 2016-2017 for Under Graduate i.e. Bachelor in Dental Surgery (BDS) Course with 1 year Internship. Application in the prescribed form are invited from the Muslim Indian National within & outside Maharashtra State & Muslim Foreign National for Admission to from 6 Religious Minorities and all other community candidates. Application in the prescribed form to be submitted along with attested xerox copies of all certificates before **20th August 2016**.

1. ELIGIBILITY

1.1 The candidate must be born on or before 31st December 1999 to be eligible for BDS course. The Birth certificate indicating name of the candidate, Secondary School Certificate i.e. SSC or equivalent examination certificate or School Leaving Certificate endorsing the date of birth will constitute a valid proof.

1.2 The candidate must be medically fit and must submit a certificate of medical fitness at the time of Admission form filling as per proforma.

1.3 The candidate must have passed the qualifying examination i.e. Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC/12th Standard) or equivalent examination with English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology) at the time of admission.

1.4 A candidate belonging to open category must secure not less than 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) taken together at National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016. A candidate belonging to constitutional reservation and constitutional reservation with Person with Disability (PWD) must secure not less

45% marks in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB) and must have passed National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016.

1.5 For NRI, Foreign And Persons pf India Origin Condition of passing of National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016 is not applicable .

2 Documents

2.1 All the Candidates who appeared for National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016 examination and desirous to take admission in the first year **B.D.S. Courses** are hereby reminded that **original documents are mandatory** at the time of filling of Admission form filling.

List of documents required at the time of Admission:

- a) Valid Photo I.D proof (Any one)- School / College ID Proof, Identity card/Aadhar card/Admit card of HSC or equivalent examination
- b) Copy of downloaded Admit Card of National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016
- c) Copy of downloaded National Eligibility and Entrance Test-2016 Statement of Marks
- d) Nationality certificate issued by District Magistrate/Addl. District Magistrate or Metropolitan Magistrate (Competent Authority for issue of such certificate)/ valid Indian passport /School Leaving Certificate of HSC/12th Std. indicating the nationality of the candidate as 'Indian'
- e) Domicile Certificate of candidates from Maharashtra State (If applicable)
- f) HSC (or equivalent) examination statement of marks
- g) SSC (or equivalent) passing certificate (for date of Birth)
- h) SSC (or equivalent) statement of marks

i) Medical fitness certificate

j) For constitutional reservation claim

a) Caste certificate

b) Caste Validity Certificate (CVC).

c) Non Creamy Layer certificate (for VJ, NT1, NT-2, NT-3 & OBC including SBC) valid up to 31/03/2017.

2.2 Documents Required for Non-Resident Indian (NRI)/Foreign and Person of India Origin

- a. Recent NRI/Foreign/PIO Status certificate of the parent issued by the Indian Embassy.
- b. Employment Certificate of the NRI/Foreign/PIO parent.
- c. NRI/Foreign/PIO bank statement of the NRI parent, at least for the last six months.
- d. Valid Indian Passport of the NRI/Foreign/PIO parent.
- e. Valid VISA of the NRI/Foreign/PIO parent.
- f. Valid Indian Passport of the Candidate or Birth Certificate.
- g. 12TH Mark Sheets of qualifying degree for all the Semesters/Consolidated Mark.
- h. 12TH Qualifying Certificate/Provisional Certificate.
- i. Foreign Nationality Students take N.O.C from Ministry of Family & Health Department, New Delhi, Government of India & Equivalent Certificate from Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.
- j. Transfer Certificate or Migration Certificate or both. If these certificates are not issued in your country, an equivalent transfer certificate from the Principal/Dean/Registrar has to be specially obtained.

3. Fees

3.1 Institution has Fixed fees of ₹ 04,00,000/- per Annum. Same fees will be charged for 4 Years and/or Subject to Approval by the Fess Regulatory Authority.

3.2 In case Fees Regulating Authority approves less Fees, then difference of amount will be refunded by Institution.

4 The Procedure for Cancellation & Refund OF Fees After Cancellation

4.1 Candidates canceling his/her admission on or before **cut-of-date** will be eligible for refund of fees.

4.2 It has been decided that if a seat is filled in and there is no vacant seat remained to be filled in by the College/Institute, in such a case the College/Institute to deduct only up to Rs.1, 000/- and balance amount of fees paid by a student to be refunded.

4.3 After prescribed date of stage above no refund shall be made.

5 DISCIPLINE:-

5.1 Any candidates / authorized representative or accompanying person is found obstructing the admission process, trying to influence in unlawful manner/creating nuisance, the candidate shall be liable for disqualification from the process of selection. The decision taken by the Management in this respect shall be final and binding.

5.2 All candidates selected shall be subject to the disciplinary rules of the institution, University, Government and Management.

6. LEGAL JURISDICTION:-

6.1 All disputes pertaining to the conduct of examination and selection process shall fall within the jurisdiction of Mumbai High Court bench at Mumbai only for the legal jurisdiction of the institution concerned.

6.2 Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik will take the decision regarding granting of the eligibility of selected candidates.

7. CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE:-

- 7.1 The students while studying in the Health Sciences Course if found indulging in anti national activities, unlawful activities or ragging in any form, contrary to the provisions of Acts and Law enacted by the Government, will be liable to be expelled from the college by the Principal of the College.
- 7.2 Failure of the candidates in making full and correct statements in the application form and /or suppression of any information will be liable for disqualification of the candidate at later stage. Such a candidates will be debarred from the entire selection process and pursuing the course of studies.
- 7.3 It is the responsibility of every candidate to submit proper documents. Any attempt to submit documents, which are not genuine, will lead to cancellation of the admission of the candidate, forfeiture of the fees, deposits and expulsion of the candidates from the college. The name of such candidates shall be deleted from the Merit list and he/ she will not be eligible for further rounds of the selection process and will be debarred from the selection process and criminal proceeding will be initiated by the College officials against such candidate or his parent.

8. Ban on RAGGING

- 8.1 **Pursuant to the order in W.P (Civil) No.656 of 1999, Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, has directed the Department of Human Recourses Development and Education Govt. of India to take all necessary steps to curb the menace of ragging and take severe action against the**

students involved in such activities. These guidelines are strictly implemented for last 5 years in this institution, as a result no incidence of ragging is reported.

8.2 As per the provision of Maharashtra act xxxiii known as “Maharashtra prohibition of ragging act of 1999” students indulging in ragging can be punished under the Act resulting in suspension , expulsion from the college and imprisonment.

8.3 Any issue not dealt here in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the principal. Student and their parent has to submit affidavit that he will not indulge in ragging and aware of punishment for indulging in ragging.

9. INSURANCE

As per GR.No.MED-100/880/CR-123/EDU-1, dated 23/10/2003 “ Amartya Shisha Yojana” , as insurance scheme has been introduced by the Govt. of Maharashtra. The details of this scheme can be taken by the candidate at the time of admission from the College.
