

ITI Scholarship Agreement.

Dear Dr. Tabrez Lakha,

On behalf of the ITI Foundation, the ITI Leadership Development Committee has awarded you an ITI Scholarship to the value of CHF 30,000 for 12 months.

You will spend 12 months at the ITI Scholarship Center at the University of Zurich, Clinic for Fixed & Removable Prosthodontics and Dental Material Science, chaired by Prof. Dr. Christoph Hammerle. Your ITI Scholarship year will begin on September 1, 2018 and end on August 31, 2019.

In order to confirm your acceptance of the ITI Scholarship place as well as the starting and end date above, please sign this agreement and email it to ITI Headquarters to scholarship@iti.org no later than December 22, 2017.

By dating and signing this agreement, the undersigned confirms and agrees to the following:

1. I agree to start and finish the Scholarship year at the above ITI Scholarship Center on the dates quoted above and to be present for the agreed period of time.
2. I am aware that, for the duration of the Scholarship year, my Scholarship Center will allow me the same annual vacation time as full-time university staff.
3. I am aware that I am responsible for applying for my visa and will provide confirmation of its receipt to the ITI Scholarship Center Chair at the latest 30 days before the starting date of my Scholarship year quoted above.
4. Should I for any reason be unable to take up my Scholarship year, I will immediately inform ITI Headquarters and the Scholarship Center in writing. If I withdraw from the program 30 or fewer days before the agreed starting date, I agree to pay a cancellation fee of CHF 1,000 to cover the administrative costs incurred.
5. If for any reason I am unable to stay for the full 12 months (starting later or finishing early) of my ITI Scholarship year, I will immediately inform ITI Headquarters and the ITI Scholarship Center Chair in writing. Additionally, I undertake to return the remainder of my Scholarship stipend to ITI Headquarters calculated on a month-by-month pro rata basis.
6. I am responsible for contacting the Scholarship Center to find out whether the Center provides professional liability insurance or whether I need to take out a professional liability insurance policy. If I have to take out the policy personally, I will do so and confirm this with the ITI Scholarship Center Chair in writing before the start of my Scholarship year.
7. I declare I will clarify whether my Scholarship stipend is subject to tax and social security deductions in my host country and will comply with any legal requirements.
8. I am aware that the ITI Scholarship stipend will be paid into an account in my own name and of which I am the sole holder. I am aware that the ITI Scholarship and the associated stipend are not transferable.
9. I am aware that the ITI Scholarship stipend is intended as a contribution towards my living expenses during the ITI Scholarship year and is to be used for this purpose only.

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


10. Should my current employer request information on or confirmation of the ITI Scholarship, I agree that ITI Headquarters can pass on this information.

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to serve as confirmation that Dr. Aamir Godil has been selected as a scholar of the International Team for Implantology at The University of Toronto / Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital in Toronto for a one-year term commencing September 1, 2022 and concluding August 31, 2023. As such he requires an Educational Visa and Work Permit for the aforementioned time period, and will be required to register with the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Ontario.

The specific details of Dr. Godil's position are as follows:

Position: Scholar of the International Team for Implantology at Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital. This position is not covered by a collective agreement;

Expected duration of employment: a one-year term commencing September 1, 2022 and concluding August 31, 2023;

Remuneration: The International Team for Implantology will support Dr. Godil with a stipend to the value of CAD 38,250 which is intended to contribute towards living costs during his scholarship year;

The nature of training to be undertaken: The University of Toronto Scholarship Center program is housed primarily at Holland Bloorview Kids Rehabilitation Hospital with its state-of-the-art dental clinic. Dr. Godil will also have the opportunity to spend time at some of the other teaching hospitals and the University of Toronto. At Holland Bloorview and the Hospital for Sick Children, Dr. Godil will be exposed to the use of dental implants in children, adolescents and young adults, along with a wide variety of unique craniofacial syndrome patients, cleft lip and palate patients, post-tumor ablation patients and patients with post-traumatic defects. Dr. Godil will participate in all phases of surgical and prosthodontic care from the initial consultation and treatment planning through post restoration maintenance and care within the framework of multidisciplinary care;

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Details of how applicant's research will be supervised: Dr. Godil will work under the direct supervision of the undersigned, and with other specialist consultants of the teaching hospitals, and will work closely together with the graduate students and fellows in prosthodontics, pediatric dentistry, orthodontics and oral and maxillofacial surgery.

Details regarding the project's Canadian funding: No additional funding is required to support Dr. Godil's training;

Details of how and why the applicant was chosen: The ITI awards up to 25 scholarships each year. This is a competitive process whereby successful awards are based on a careful assessment of the applicant's credentials by the Scholarship Committee.




