






Date: 23rd February 2023



Date: 5th September 2023




the nation's sanitation and well-being. Students actively participated in a cleanliness drive, where they cleaned the college premises, spreading the message of cleanliness in action.

Such little steps taken together by the college and students will surely help in fostering strong mental and social health amongst students so that they can connect with their peers, their elders, their community and their environment.




