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Hierarchy of Governance

Maharashtra Cosmopolitan Education (MCE) Society Trust: Is the main governing body under whose authority and policies M. A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences and Research Centre functions.

Local Managing Committee (LMC): All policy decisions made by this committee. The committee also decides the allocation of the annual budget and oversees the overall functioning of the college.

Principal: Is the head of the college and is responsible for all the academic and administrative functioning of the college.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC): Through various statutory and non-statutory committees, it ensures all the policies are implemented and the vision and mission of the college are achieved to their maximum. It is responsible for developing and implementing the standard operating procedures (SOP's) of various committees. It periodically evaluates the functioning of the college, feedback of stakeholders and ensures that any shortcomings and grievances are redressed at the earliest.

College Development Committee (CDC): Comprises of the Principal and Heads of all the departments in the college. They are responsible for the day-to-day implementation of policies, functioning of the departments, as well as the academic activities of their specialties. The Heads of the departments also help the principal update the library, equipment and infrastructure of the college.

Teaching Faculty: Is responsible to ensure that the best quality of education and training is imparted to the students. They also ensure that patient care is of the best quality. In addition, they help the Heads of departments in carrying out the day-to-day activities in the department. The faculty also are members of various committees and thereby are involved in the decentralized administration and participatory governance.
