## Report of Mega Health Camp, Pune

A Dental Screening and Treatment Camp was organized at the agriculture college ground, Shivajinagar, Pune on 04/08/2024 under the guidance of Dr. Ramandeep Dugal, Principal, M. A. Rangoonwala Dental College and the NSS unit of our college along with Public Health Department, in collaboration with Someshwar Foundation and Niramaya Seva Foundation at Agriculture College Ground, Shivaji Nagar, Pune from 08:00 am to 5:00 pm. A team of 50 students, 9 teaching staff and 3 non-teaching staff of M. A. Rangoonwala College of Dental Sciences and Research Center attended this camp. 96 patients were screened. In spite of heavy rain, the dedicated team provided the oral health education to patients at the camp. The patients were examined for various dental problems and were instructed about how to maintain proper oral hygiene and about proper brushing techniques and use of oral hygiene aids in a proper manner. Dental treatment options were also explained to them. The participants were given certificates of appreciation for rendering selfless service to the community.
